Service to be provided:	Sessional Counsellor
Rates:	£22 per hour-long counselling session. This fee to include all regular client administrative tasks. The rate for additional meetings or admin tasks, where required and pre-agreed, will be £11 per hour. Counselling rooms will be provided free of charge. This role is on a self-employed basis.
Hours:	Flexible
Based at:	The Wellbeing Centre, 23b Chester Street, Mold and/or home based for on-line and telephone work.

Contractor requirements	 Counsellors must be qualified and have completed a course that is accredited by BACP or UKCP Completed as a minimum a primer training for working online. Must have over 250 client hours Must be a member of the BACP or another recognised professional body Have personal counsellors' insurance Be up to date with CPD hours and be responsible for recording the required hours Counsellors are responsible for supervision every month and the cost.
Aims of the service	To deliver brief or longer-term counselling to adults experiencing mild to moderate mental health problems
The service provider will:	 Counselling Be responsible for a caseload of counselling clients with mild to moderate mental health problems. Deliver individual assessment to clients (when qualified and experienced enough to do so) Deliver counselling to clients Abide by North East Wales Minds policies and procedures Maintain and update accurate database records of clients (using North East Wales Mind's in-house database)

- Accurately and efficiently manage all administration processes, including arranging appointments.
